



To whom it may concern:

We have been enjoying the installation of our new CAP Clean Air Plant System in our Sheet-Fed Press Room at our Pomeroy facility in Parsippany, New Jersey, for about a year.

Prior to the installation of our CAP units, solvent odors and odor particles were strong throughout the plant, offices, and even the parking lot.

Now, there is no trace of odor or contaminants anywhere in the plant, outside the press room. Just outside the press room, no solvents are detected with a MiniRAE2000 VOC analyzer. Readings inside the press room are down to only about 1 ppm.

This is a total containment of about 200 lb/day of solvents and odor particles generated in the press room. The destruction rates of solvent are near 99%. All of our employees are happy about these results, which improve morale and productivity.

This is good news for those printers and others that are reaching the maximum 25,000 lb/yr generation that puts them under Title V.

Because we now have control of our discharges, we can lower our venting rates. We anticipated that the CAPs will pay for themselves in HVAC and other utility savings in 16 months based on our ROI Analysis.

The program with 12 months of operation behind us, is on track to have the system pay for itself in 16 months hitting our original Return on Investment goals and objectives. Additionally the superior air quality and the improvement to health & human safety is priceless, along with the reduction of our environmental footprint impact.

We at Earth Color feel that improving our sustainability and carbon profile are good for business.
